MUSICAL - OVERVIEW

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1) Caste Overview:

The caste consists of:

Three young guys:

- Rudy,
- Johnny
- Franky

all between the ages of 25 - 30 years.

Three young girls:

- Jennifer (Jen)
- Pamela (Pam)
- Roberta

all between the ages age of 25 - 30 years.

All of these <u>six</u> people grew up in the same town in the USA and have similar background education and school experience etc..

2) Basic Story Lines:

Story line #1: Rudy and Jennifer (Jen)

Rudy and Jennifer are a close boy and girlfriend who have lived together for about two years. However, over the past few months, Rudy has been deeply interest in developing his musical skills by being the leader in his local rock band and, as such, has been almost completely ignoring Jennifer.

So over the past few months, Jennifer has become more and more frustrated and pissed off with Rudy to point of actually walking out on him and moving in with her Aunt.

However, after being separated for a few weeks and going through the somewhat traumatic experience of possibly losing their old friend Johnny in a car crash, both Rudy and Jennifer missed each other badly and finally decided to move back in together again.

Story line #2: Johnny and Pamela

Johnny and Pamela met at an early age at Secondary school. After being close friends for some time, Johnny declared that he was actually in love with Pamela. Pamela also felt that she was in love with Johnny.

However, as they grew older, Johnny's interest in Pamela actually waned as he became more and more interested in driving and repairing old cars to the point where him built and owned his own hot rod car. Following which he lost almost all interest in Pamela.

Eventually, Johnny mistakenly went too fast when turning a corner, ran his car over the embankment making his car a complete right-off, Johnny felt so embarrassed and upset about himself that he decided to run away and hide for a bit.

This entire experience forced Johnny to reconsider his living situation primarily realizing that he had really missed Pamela to the point where he considered that they should maybe get married.

Story line #3: Franky and Roberta

Franky was basically a regular guy with very normal behaviour and opinions. However, Roberta was quite the opposite to the point of being dressing and behaving like a complete hippy person. Roberta was not really good at doing anything including her main hobby of trying to learn and play guitar.

Franky tries many times to get Roberta interest in dating him but with no luck. Eventually however after Roberta has tried many different interests including clothing, make up and music etc. Roberta finally becomes more interested and passionate about Franky. After which they do become a regular boy and girlfriend.

3) Musical Requirements:

It is proposed that for this musical production, the band should remain far left on the stage throughout the entire show. It is also proposed that the band members can/will join in and sing or accompany several of the more rocky songs.

Musical Styles:

The music required throughout this production requires **two** basic musical styles:

- a) A typical Rock n' Roll accompaniment for the several straight rock songs.
- b) A gentler 'folky' guitar type of sound to accompany the more gentle ballads.

For several of the 'rock' style tunes, members of the rock band themselves will sings these songs. The term 'band' will be used with these tunes.

For several of the 'rock' style tunes, members of the cast will be required to sing them - which could present a possible challenge.

For all of the 'ballad' style tunes, members of the cast will be required to sing them.

Instrumentation:

The band will require the following instruments:

- Simple drum set
- Electric piano
- Bass quitar
- 6 string and 12 string rhythm guitars
- Electric lead guitar

Vocal Requirements:

Two types of vocal styles will be required as follows:

a) Rock Style:

Straight 'heavy' rock style as usually sung by males, needed to sing the several rock songs.

This could be provided by the actual band members who can also directly participate throughout the show.

b) Ballad Style:

A gentler and more softer style needed for all 'ballad' style songs as sung by all members of the cast throughout the show.

4) Who Sings What:

Band:

Means that the members of the Band providing all background music will actually sing this song themselves.

Ensemble:

means that the six members of the cast will sing this song themselves.

- a) For several of the 'rock' style tunes, members of the rock band themselves can join in with caste members and sings these songs. The term 'band' will be used with these tunes.
- b) For several of the 'rock' style tunes, members of the cast will be required to sing them which could present a possible challenge.
- c) For all of the 'ballad' style tunes, members of the cast will be required to sing them.
